

Privacy Policy

The District Council of Yankalilla is subject to the Privacy Act 1988 including the National Privacy Principles. We respect your privacy and recognise the importance of protecting the privacy of information collected about visitors to the Festival of Nature. This privacy statement applies to our website – www.yankalilla.sa.gov.au – information collected when booking or on site during events, and governs the manner in which your personal information will be dealt with. By using our website and participating in events, you consent to the collection, use and disclosure of personal information, but only in accordance with this privacy statement.

Collection of Personal Information

We may collect personal information from you including your name, address, telephone number, email address or other such personal information when you email us, register to participate in events or enter competitions.

Use of Personal Information

We use your personal information as follows: (a) to reply to your queries or provide you with the services you have requested (for example, to supply you with tickets for an event you have booked); (b) purposes related to the promotion and marketing of the Festival of Nature including information or periodic emailing on future events; and (c) statistical purposes.

Access to your Personal Information

We take all reasonable steps to ensure that the personal information we collect is accurate and up to date. You can however request that personal information about you be corrected or deleted.

Disclosure to Third Parties

We will not disclose your personal information to any third party unless otherwise required by law or in the interest of public safety. Any and all of the information collected by us will be kept strictly confidential and will not be sold, reused, rented, disclosed or loaned. The information that is collected from you is for the sole purpose of providing you with information about events and activities. Any information you provide will be held with the utmost care and will not be used in ways you have not consented to. If you have any questions, please feel free to contact us.

Security

We take all reasonable steps to ensure the security, integrity and privacy of personal information supplied to us. Unfortunately, no data transmission over the internet can be regarded as totally secure and therefore District Council of Yankalilla is not responsible for events arising from any unauthorised access to your personal information.

Opt-Out

In any promotional communication with you, District Council of Yankalilla will advise you how to notify us if you do not wish to receive any further communications.
