Activities

1. Make an Easter basket

Use an egg carton or box, staple or tape a cardboard handle on. Decorate with paint, textas or glue on colourful paper. Cut up strips of paper to place inside your basket.

2. Egg decorating

Use cooled hard boiled eggs, draw patterns and shapes with crayons. Place in a container with water and food colouring. Experiment with how many drops needed to colour the eggs.

3. Biscuit decorating

Use an oval shaped biscuit bought or handmade. Cover with icing (Icing sugar, water and food colouring). Use sprinkles, sultanas and marshmallows to decorate.
