The *Local Nuisance and Litter Control Act 2016* is significant legislation for councils in South Australia and is anticipated will assist in resolving local nuisance complaints. The Act also has a strong focus on managing littering and illegal dumping across South Australia.

The Act confers a significant role on to councils to implement the legislation and this form is to be used when wishing to communicate with Council a matter of concern.

Domestic sources of odours include:

- Insanitary conditions
- Dirty or poorly maintained rubbish bins and waste receptacles
- Uncovered compost heaps
- Rotting vegetation or food scraps (particularly sea-food)
- Storage of petrochemicals (oils, degreasers, kerosene)

Generally the greater the frequency, intensity, duration or offensiveness of an odour, the more likely it is to cause annoyance to people and result in complaints.

The Act allows Council to consider granting exemptions from local nuisance-causing activities for short-term activities such as festivals, events or major construction activities. All exemptions are published on the Council's website. Please check prior to submitting form.
